Task Description: The Learner will read and interpret a store flyer, answer questions orally and follow instructions.

Main Competency/Task Group/Level Indicator:

Materials Required:

- Pen/pencil and paper and/or digital device
- Bills (\$5 and \$10) and coins (\$.05, \$.10, \$.25, \$1, \$2)

Notes for Instructors/Practitioners

Give your learner a selection of bills and coins they can use to "buy" items in the flyer. After they have had a chance to review the flyer, ask them orally the questions listed below.

Note: The flyer indicates that all items are tax free, so the learner does not need to calculate tax. However, you may wish to discuss rounding to the nearest 0.05 (to account for no pennies when paying with cash) if your learner is not yet familiar with this.

QUESTIONS to ask learners

Task 1: What is the purpose of this flyer?

Task 2: Most flyers have a start and end date. What are the start and end dates for this sale?

Task 3: You would like to buy one package of Great Company Coffee Pods. Using the coins, show how much money you would need to give to the clerk to pay for it. Will you get any change back? If yes, show approximately how much change you will get back.

Task 4: Use the "Pharmasave Shopping Information" chart as your shopping list and write the price beside each item as given in the flyer.


Learner Information

Answer: December 13 and December 26, 2024

Task 3: You would like to buy one package of Great Company Coffee Pods. Using the coins, show how much money you would need to give to the clerk to pay for it. Will you get any change back? If yes, show approximately how much change you will get back.

Answer: The item costs \$4.99 The learner should count out at least \$5 and estimate change accordingly.

Task 4: Use the "Pharmasave Shopping Information" chart as your shopping list and write the price beside each item as given in the flyer.
